What's New, What's not?

- **NEW** Complimentary Shuttle runs every twenty minutes on the hour: Shuttle Phone +1-703-415-1300; 5:00 AM- 12:00 midnight.

- TPPC Host hotel: Residence Inn Arlington Capital View; 2850 South Potomac Avenue, Arlington, VA, 22202. The TPPC block contains 30 rooms; first come, first served.

- Hotel block closes at 5 PM EST on February 6, 2018. Check with the hotel about their cancelation and cash deposit policies.

- The hotel does NOT require a deposit at the time of booking.
- You are responsible for any hotel incidentals and will be required to provide a payment method upon check-in.
- Upon check-in, the hotel authorizes the total amount of the guest stay plus \$20 per day for incidentals. Even if UCDE prepays for your room, you will be responsible for covering the daily incidental amount.

Refreshments at the Meeting Site

- Morning refreshments at the meeting site will include coffee/tea/water service only.
