1. TPPC Working Group Guidelines and Rules

Loren shared the TPPC Working Group Rules and Breakouts Template as a reminder to the group that those resources existed and to create a document with this work group's specific goals and deliverables. Working group members will comment on the Workgroup Breakouts Template for this working group.

2. Create new pollinator assessment tool for Tribes

One of the Working Group's goals is to create a fillable assessment tool for Tribes to assess their pollinator issues. Brittani shared the survey done by Ed Spevak with the St. Louis Zoo as a resource to create a TPPC Pollinator Assessment. Jasmine shared an old survey used by the previous pollinator protection workgroup. Loren and Amanda will put together a list of questions to the regions, share with the pollinator working group, and share on the next regional call May 18. These questions, plus previous surveys, will inform the new pollinator assessment tool, to be discussed at next monthly working group call.

3. Identify topics of interest related to pollinators
